DAAD is an organization of German universities to promote international relations between universities. There are exchange programmes for academics in **all** subjects in Germany and nearly every country in the world.

DAAD is financed by the *Deutsche Bundestag* (German National Parliament), various ministries, the states of the Federal Republic of Germany, the *Foundation for German Science* and the *EU Commission*.

DAAD headquarters is in Bonn. There are offices in Jakarta, Cairo, London, Moscow, New Delhi, New York, Paris, Beijing, Rio de Janeiro, San José, Tokyo and Warsaw.

## **(1.) Graduates**

(1.1) One year scholarships

(1.2) Short term fellowships

### *(1.1) One year scholarships*

- *For graduates in all fields. Duration one academic year, October–July*
- Age limit 32
- Knowledge of German important, to be acquired prior to the grant. Language courses of 2 to 4 months are sponsored by DAAD

## *Purpose*

- (i) Advanced study or research, but not for a degree to be taken in Germany
- (ii) Research for a degree to be taken in the home country
- (iii) Participation in a postgraduate course by a German institution of higher education
- (iv) Study for a doctorate degree to be taken in Germany

scholarships of category (iii) and (iv) may be extended

## *Application material*

- Application form
- CV
- Detailed research plan
- Letters of reference (2)
- Letter of invitation from a German university
- Certificates
- Language certificates
- Health certificates

## *(1.2) Short term fellowships*

- *For graduates and post-graduates in all fields. Duration 1 to 6 months*
- Age limit 35
- Applicants are expected to submit a *detailed research plan* and need a *German academic supervisor* who has agreed to the proposed schedule



## *Purpose*

- Education of young scientists
- Promotion of scientific cooperation and academic exchanges
- Completing a well-defined research project
- Collecting material for a dissertation

*Application material as in (1.1) + Time Schedule, but no language certificate required*

**Cannot be extended**

*Requirements* **Excellent student record and exams, high scientific standard of the proposed research project**

### *(5.1) Study Visits*

*For scientists with a Ph.D. degree, all subjects, working at a university or a research institution*

#### *Purpose*

- (i) Promotion of scientific exchange and co-operation
- (ii) Internationalization of German universities
- (iii) Completing a well-defined research project of limited duration in Germany
- (iv) Cooperation with colleagues.

*Requirements.* A well-defined, detailed programme for a work and research project with the host institution, and an invitation by the host institution.

**No study visit within the previous two years**

## *Duration*

1 to 3 months

**No extension**

## *Application material*

- Application form
- CV
- Detailed description of the project
- Invitation from the host institution

## *(5.2) Short-term Lecturerships*

*For German professors to visit foreign universities*

### *Purpose*

- (i) Promotion of academic exchange and scientific cooperation with Germany
- (ii) Establishing and developing relations
- (iii) Enhancement of the curricula of the host university
- (iv) Education of young scientists at the host university

- (v) Internationalization of studies at the host university
- (vi) Completing a well defined project of teaching of limited duration at the host university
- (vii) Further qualifying the German Professor

*Requirements.* Ph.D. degree, well-defined project of teaching in consent with the host university, invitation, financial contribution and description of the position by the host university.

*Duration*

4 weeks to 6 months.

**No extension**

### *(5.3) Long-term Lecturerships*

*For German professors to work at foreign universities*

*Purpose as in (5.2) plus*

- (i) Support for the staff of the host university
- (ii) Support in establishing and developing new subjects
- (iii) Visiting Professor for a longer period of time

*Requirements.* German nationality, residence in Germany for the previous two years, Ph.D. degree, qualification for a professorship, teaching experience, willingness to integrate in the

system of the host university, existing contact with the host university, invitation, announcement of a vacancy with job description, financial contribution by the host university

### *Duration*

1 to 5 years

### *Application material*

- Application form (to be filled in by the host university)
- Nomination by the host university
- Advertisement of the position by DAAD
- Application form for the Visiting Professor
- CV
